Recently she has been a member of the POST Guidelines committee focused on potential revisions to the Crowd Management, Intervention, and Control Guidelines pertaining to the use of Kinetic Energy Projectiles (KEPs) and Chemical Agents in order to comport with recent legislative changes.

Throughout her career, Ms. Rohr has been a guest lecturer and speaker for police and sheriff's departments, as well as for

law enforcement organizations, including CPOA, POST, FBI and Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department.
